NOTICE OF ESTIMATE OF SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFIT

We will use a "Social Security Offset" in computing the 1.5 formula of your pension benefit (see "Retirement Information, Pension Plan Formula" set forth at line J on page 2). This offset is computed using a table of expected Social Security benefits for an individual of your age with six percent per year increase in earnings during the base period used to determine such benefit. In most cases, this estimated benefit will be slightly less than the actual benefit you will receive resulting in a slightly higher pension benefit amount. However, you have the right to have your pension calculated using your actual Social Security benefit if you are 62 or older or using a projected Social Security benefit based upon your actual Social Security wage history if you are not yet age 62.

If you want to have your actual Social Security benefit or a projected benefit based on actual Social Security wage history, you must do the following within six months of the date of this notice:

1. If you are age 62 or over, simply present a copy of your letter of benefit award from social security. Be certain that your award is calculated on the basis of your earnings up to your retirement date.
2. If you are not yet 62 present a copy of a "Statement of Social Security Earnings" which you can obtain without charge from the Social Security Administration. A "Request for Social Security Earnings Information," Form SSA-7004-SM-OP-1 is available from any Social Security Office. The information we need to calculate your Social Security benefit is the Yearly Totals of Earnings information on the "Request for Social Security Earnings Information." DO NOT request Detail Earnings information for this purpose.

Your benefit will not be reduced if the actual Social Security computation is greater than the estimated amount utilized when your pension is initially calculated. However, your benefit will be increased if the calculated Social Security benefit is less than the estimated amount.

You will be informed of the results of any Social Security recalculation within 60 days of our receipt of your letter of award or statement of earnings.
